Guidelines for Abstracts

- All the abstracts must be original work of the author/s, which have not been presented or submitted for consideration to be published elsewhere.
- · Prospective authors must prepare the abstract in MS Word.
- All the abstracts must be written in English.
- The abstract should briefly point out the research problem, objectives, methodology, and findings.
- The length of the abstracts should not exceed 300 words.
- The title should be concise and should be centered.
- Font type has to be, Times New Roman.
- Font size has to be, Topic 14 Bold. However, surname/s with initials, email address of the corresponding author, and affiliation, country have to be in 12 bold.
- Please indicated the email address of the corresponding author.
- Number of keywords have to be not more than five (5) keywords in Italics.
- Notification of acceptance or rejection will be sent to the corresponding author.
- Accepted abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings online.
